Mr Hambley Dear Sir

I received your letter several days ago and will try to reply & am very sorry indeed you have been put to so much trouble about the small amount of money but it has been a good deal of trouble to us besides the thoughts of you all thinking hard of us some people dissatisfied Dallas with his house last fall so we did not know what to do every time I would talk to him he would say let his money stay there and the others were on the river and we cant get any of our letters to go there that we write Sam meyer come out Christmas set in on the Byongh 12 miles from hear and he scarcely ever comes out he wrote to me several times & me to him on buisness but our letters never passed so people in Ark cant imagine how it has been with us it is all Dallas's

fault Mr. Healey went to see him a month
or so ago he said then he was willing for
his Pa to send for it Dallas is doing very
well know he done very bad for awhile
If every one knew how honest Mr. Healey
was they would not blame him he has
wrote to you once or twice I wrote to Sam
in the winter several times to come out or
