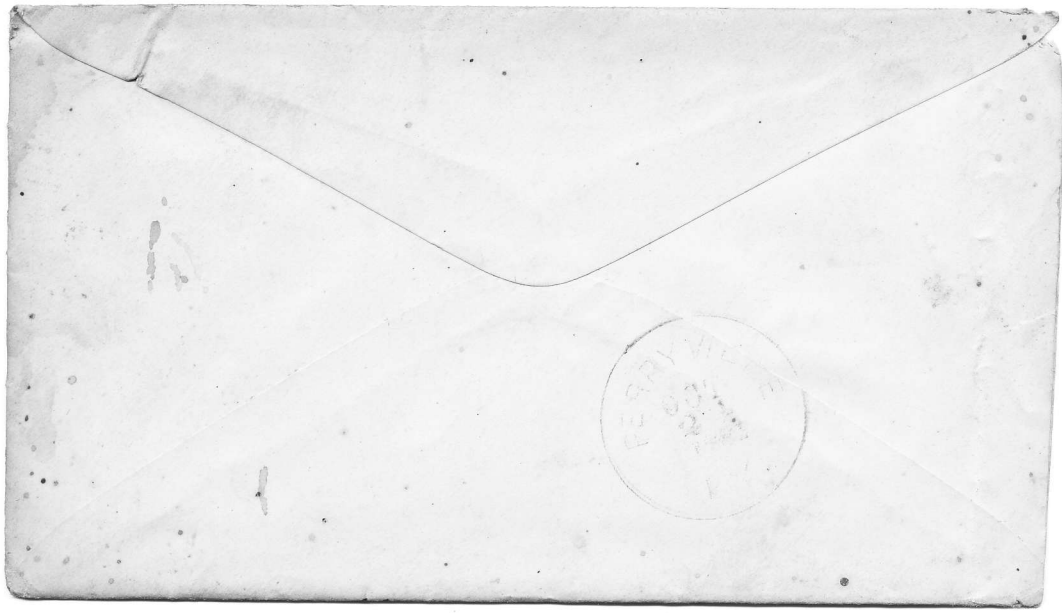

Mr Hawley

I have recd a letter from
Alvy, did not see him when in
Kentucky, he says he does
not want the place -

I wrote to Alvy that as you was
on the ground and had charge of
Wiley Kings part of the place, I
had admitted you by letter to
also take charge of and collect
my rents & manage my interest, in
connection with Wiley. Alvy
has paid \$8.75 for fine - Taxes 1880
\$4.55 & Taxes 1881 \$3.35 Total \$16.65
from Aunt recd for rents \$157.50 loan
due me \$140.85, This year rent
you will collect & receipts for and
let me know when I will
write you what to do with it.

I have written to Wiley, in
regard to the sale of the land

and I think he will direct me to
see, I ought to be worth \$2500
1/2 cash & balance in one year
with interest, I think you could
afford to give that for it.

You will please write to me
on receipt of this what you
wish to do, I do not wish to
rent it for another year if you
can see
